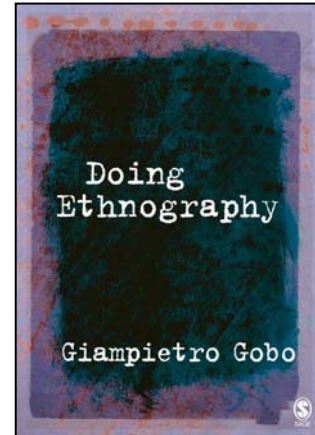


Doing Ethnography
